General: All visitors and campers will please register at office.

Office hours for arrival/check-in are 8 a.m.-Noon and 1 - 5 p.m. Evening canteen or late arrivals need to be arranged ahead of time.

Quiet hours are 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. and during meeting times.

Lodge rooms will be available after 3 p.m.

Check-out time is 11 a.m. Check out at the office before you leave.

Charges for repairs or replacement will be assessed and billed to the camper.

Please be quiet and courteous around other campers.

Please play only PG or G rated movies on TV and VCR.

Return any picnic tables, fire rings, and portable grills to their original location.

Please do not remove furniture from buildings.

Please do not block drives or access around buildings; this is a fire hazard.

Report any damage, problems, or injuries at the office.

Children must be supervised by adults.

Please act, dress, or talk in a way that would honor Christ.

For your safety, shoes should be worn at all times.

Please don't litter the grounds or buildings.

Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are prohibited.

Use caution if you smoke. Don't smoke in buildings. Don't litter.

No fireworks.

No one is permitted on climbing wall or ropes courses without D.M. Instructors.

Pool: Swim at your own risk. We provide no lifeguard. Pool hours determined by D.M. staff.

Children under 12 must be supervised by an adult (over 17).

Never swim alone. Use the buddy system.

Please shower before entering pool or after using sun lotion.

Don't wear frayed cut-offs.

Dress modestly. (Wear non-white t-shirts over two-piece suits.)

Wear shoes to and from pool.

Don't hang on rope, run or rough-house in the pool area.

No glass, food or drink is allowed into the pool area.

Fires: **Build fires in metal fire rings and 20 feet from trees, tents or RVs.**

Use only dead wood. Never cut or harm live trees.

Fires are prohibited during drought or windy conditions.

All fires must be attended or completely out (drowned).

Don't put unburnable or toxic items in fires.

Pets: We recommend you not bring pets.

Pets are not allowed in the buildings.

Pets must be confined or leashed and supervised at all times.

You will need to remove your pet if it is a nuisance to campers or staff.

Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after pet and any damage the pet does.

Equipment: Equipment for ping pong, carpet ball, disc golf, etc. may be checked out in canteen/office. A deposit is required, and you will be charged for lost or damaged equipment.
